



## Current COVID Restrictions

*(Updated January 20, 2021)*

### Facility Rules / COVID Restrictions

*The Community First Champion Center (CFCC) is owned by the city of Grand Chute and operates in collaboration with the Fox Cities Convention and Visitors Bureau. The administration of the CFCC, the city of Grand Chute and the Fox Cities CVB continue to work to modify all COVID restrictions to ensure the safety of all participants, spectators and staff. The following restrictions comply with the most recent update of limitations. Thank you for working with us to provide a safe environment.*

1. All fans, players and coaches are required to wear a mask while in the facility.
2. Spectators are limited. The number of spectators allowed per player or team will be determined for each event. There are multiple factors that impact the number of spectators per player or team which is why some events have different numbers. All limitations fall within our total capacity for each space.
3. The Champion Center will provide wristbands for the teams' spectators. Each day and session the wristbands are different. **Each team should assign one person to collect the money and pick up the wristbands from the Champion Center 30 minutes prior to your first game at the Main Entrance.**
4. **Spectators will not be allowed into the facility until the previous wave has cleared. First waves of the day will be allowed in 15 minutes prior to the first game. NO GAMES WILL START UNTIL SPECTATORS ARE IN THE FACILITY. All spectators will enter through the Main Entrance. (#1 on the Facility Map)**
5. Spectators, please clear the Fieldhouse, Seasonal Arena or Main Ice Rink and the facility as quickly as possible after your team's wave is complete. This allows us to keep games on schedule. Thank you for your cooperation.
6. Players, coaches and a parent rep may enter the facility 30 minutes prior to their session start time, through the Player and Coach Entrance. (#10 - Hockey, #11 - Basketball & Volleyball)
